

The OLD Claiborne County Jail is the oldest free standing jail in Tennessee and the past two years have seen major renovations on the jail itself. The new roof was installed in 2012 and in 2013 we were able with the help of federal grants to repair the front and south side of the building to prevent further deterioration. To continue with this restoration of the exterior and to start on the interior reconstruction we need your help. The Society has decided that a plaza in front of the jail would be a wonderful enhancement to the site and allow continued fundraising in a way that enhances the area for the entire county.
